- 1) Why can this parable be a little confusing and hard to understand?
- 2) According to the parable, what should we do with our worldly wealth?
- 3) What tends to be our society's attitude towards wealth?
- 4) What does Jesus mean when he says in verse 10: "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much"? How is this linked to having an eternal perspective?

Going Deeper

- 5) Why is the love of money, and serving it, so dangerous? Why has it taken so many people off the narrow path?
- 6) How might we know if we are serving money rather than God?
- 7) In what ways does Jesus demonstrate that He is the model of being a trustworthy steward?
