

“NO WORD FROM GOD WILL EVER FAIL”

Luke 1:37 (NIV)

Our goal is to extol the supreme value of being *truth-full* (full of God’s truth). The fact is that we can’t really be *rest-full* if we’re not truth-full. It is the single most important key to ministering from a position of *fullness*. And there is *no fullness without truth-fullness*. There is no happiness, blessedness, fruitfulness without truth-fullness. Truth-fullness essentially boils down to this: *choosing to believe what God says about what God says* (i.e. choosing to believe what God says about His very words). So, let’s remind ourselves of what He says about His Word.

- God’s word is life!
  - “It’s impossible to separate the written Word from the living Word” (John 1:1). Explain.
  - How do you put Matthew 4:4 into practice?
  
- God’s word is answered prayer!
  - Tim Keller has written, “*We know how we should be praying only by getting our vocabulary from the Bible. Our starting point for prayer must be immersion in God’s Word.*” How does this fit with John 15:5?
  
- God’s word is freedom!
  - What kind of freedom is Jesus talking about in John 8:32?
  - In what sense does God’s Word enable us to be free according to Psalm 119:9, 11?
  
- God’s word is blessedness!

Psalm 1:3 promises specific blessings for those who delight in God's law (Word). Explain the blessing implied in each phrase:

  - “*He is like a tree planted*”
  - “*by streams of water*”
  - “*that yields its fruit*”
  - “*in its season*”
  - “*its leaf does not wither*”
  - “*and in all he does, he prospers*”
