## Discussion Questions

### The Essentials

- 1) What is comfort according to the world?
- 2) Why might God allow us to suffer more than we can endure, like Paul?
- 3) The word 'comfort' in our text is *paraclete* in Greek. What does this mean? Can you think of other examples in Scripture where this word is used?
- 4) What does the word *paraclete* tell us about the comfort that God gives us?

### Going Deeper

- 5) What is the difference between the peace that God offers us and the relief that we tend to seek in the world?
- 6) What are some examples of Jesus receiving comfort from the suffering He endured?
- 7) According to the text, why do we receive comfort?

**Memory Verse:** "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, <sup>4</sup>who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God." 2 Corinthians 1:3-4
