Discussion Questions

The Essentials

- 1) How does love cost us?
- 2) Love isn't easily angered. How was Moses easily angered? What were the consequences of this? What do we learn from this?
- 3) Love isn't resentful, so we must learn to forgive one another (Matthew 6:15). How do we forgive someone? Why does this also come at a cost?
- 4) Jesus is love incarnate. How does his life and teachings demonstrate these verses?

Going Deeper

- 5) Love rejoices with the truth. How might it cost us to rejoice with the truth in a society that doesn't believe in objective truth?
- 6) How did Jesus rejoice when spiritual truth was revealed?
- 7) How do we see love displayed in the trinity? Discuss this quote from Michael Reeves: "Since God the Father has eternally loved His Son, it is entirely characteristic of him to turn and create others that He might also love them".
